

On behalf of the editorial team at the Journal of Language and Literacy Education, we would like to thank you for your service this year as a member of our Editorial Review Board. Your scholarly insight and feedback has been invaluable to all of our authors. Many of our submitting authors commented on how helpful your reviews were in their revision process.

We received 76 submitted manuscripts this year and sent 69 of these out for peer review. At this time, we are averaging 2 days for desk rejects and 41 days for all other decisions (out for peer review, presented to the editorial team, decision sent out to author).
